



James showed he is a force to be reckoned with when he switches on. As our striker he contributed many goals this year.



Another year gone.....


Now the third year in the making with majority of the same boys this team has had a good year. Only 2 losses. NON COMPETETIVE MY FOOT.





Every Tuesday and Thursday nights at training we had the boy's turn up wich was always great to see how dedicated they were.


In the end we would finish the competition as minor premiers, we would meet Austral in the semi finals wich we won 3 -2 and we progressed straight to the grand final.


